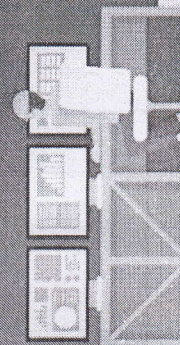
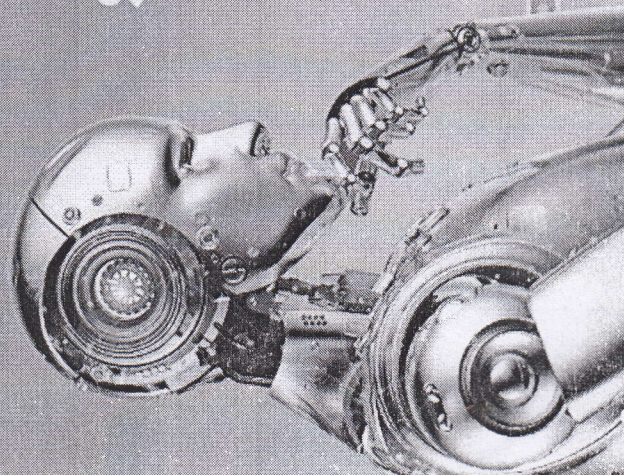



Webinar topic: RURAL YOUTH AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT

India has a high proportion of rural youth, which accounts for about 65% of the country's youth population. They have limited access to a number of programmes pertaining to their future prospect as well country's growth. Rural young women have even greater difficulties than young men as they are often not given the same opportunities in education, training and other activities.

So, there is a need to have a systematic approach to creating a suitable environment to develop opportunities for gainful employment of the rural youth. This can be achieved by adopting a responsive entrepreneurial ecosystem that may identify the talent of rural youth to make them absorb in economic activities. Usually rural youth lack 'soft skills' that is, the ability to experiment with new ideas. Skilling initiatives should be taken for improvement of their confidence level so that the gap between the rural and urban youths be bridged with proper value addition. This can help to cater on their personality development skills, management skills, language & communication skills, behavioural skills, employability skills etc.

With this objective for improvement of physical and mental development of rural youth of the country by providing skills, "RURAL YOUTH AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT" has been chosen as the topic of this Webinar.
